Applications in the prescribed format are hereby invited from eligible, interested local candidates (indigenous inhabitants belonging to Scheduled Tribes of Nagaland) for entrance test to shortlist 30 candidates for availing of coaching at Vajiram & Ravi, New Delhi. The cost for the coaching shall be borne by the Government. Accommodation/transportation cost shall be borne by the student. **Candidates who have already undergone UPSC Coaching either from Government or private need not apply.**

- **Minimum Educational Qualifications:** The candidates must hold a Bachelor's degree with at least 60% marks secured from a Recognised University.
